System requirements

To take advantage of AppConfig, verify you adhere to the following prerequisites:

- **Acrobat Reader:** The latest version is available from the Apple Store via the Mobile Iron UI. AppConfig support began with 16.12.13.
- **OS:** Requires iOS 8.4 or later. Compatible with iPhone, iPad, and iPod touch.
- Acrobat Reader and been tested and certified with its partner MobileIron.

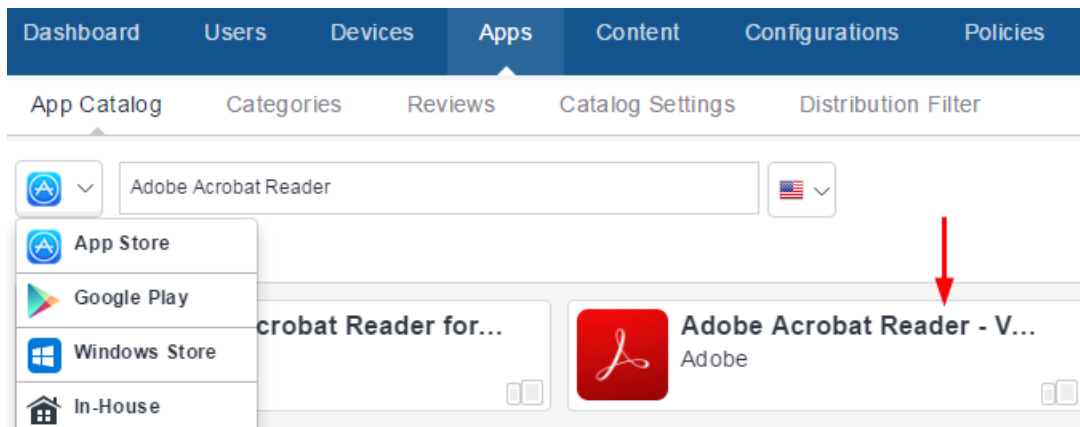
App Deployment

To import Acrobat Reader from the Apple Store and configure it for deployment, do the following:

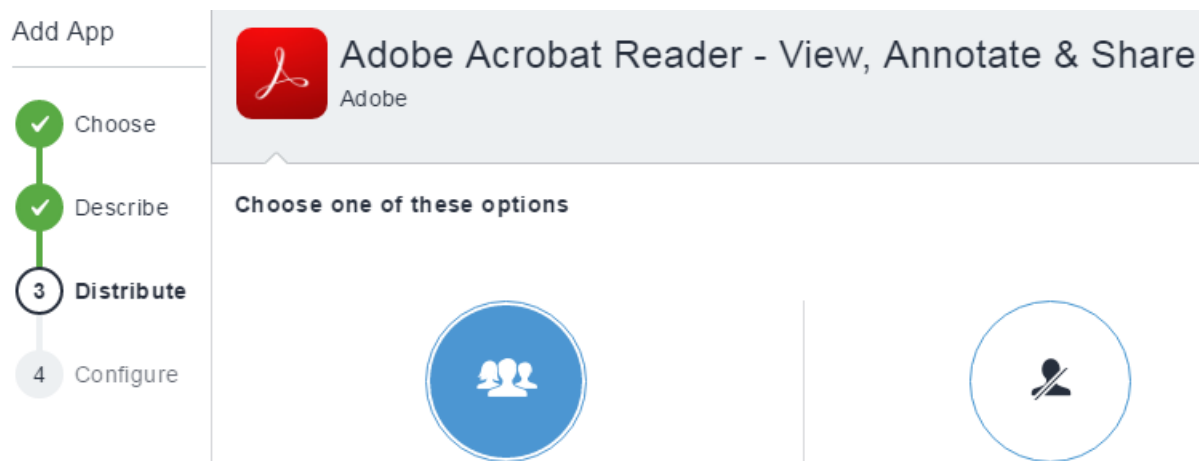
1. Open the MobileIron Core Admin Portal.



2. Go to **Apps > App Catalog**.
3. Choose **Add**.
4. Select the Apple Store from the drop-down list.
5. Search for “Adobe Acrobat Reader”.
6. Highlight **Adobe Acrobat Reader**. *Do not select the version that has Intune in the name and a blue top right corner.*
7. Choose **Next**.

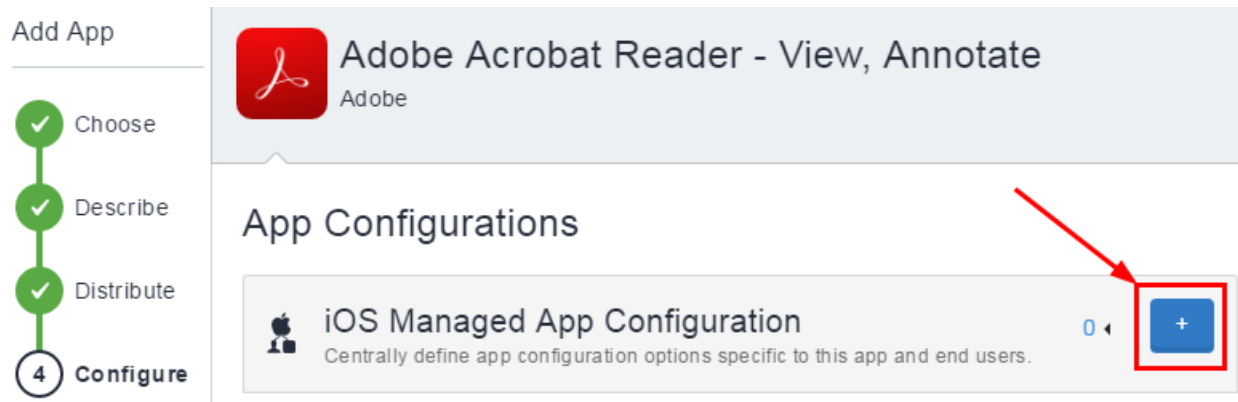


8. You are now at the *Describe* page. From here you can:
 - Add tags in the **Category** field so that users can more easily find this app in the catalog.
 - Add optional comments for the end user in the **Description** field.
9. Choose **Next**.
10. Choose your distribution options.
11. Choose **Next**.





- Under **App Configurations**, click the + sign to the right of iOS Managed App Configuration.



- For each feature list, configure the settings.
- Enter a name for the configuration.
- Click **Add Description** to enter an optional description for this configuration.



- Check or uncheck each feature to enable or disable it.





Application Features

- Enable copy & paste
- Enable spotlight indexing

File Systems

- Enable Document Cloud and Creative Cloud file systems
- Enable Dropbox file system
 - Controls the availability of the Dropbox file system

18. Choose **Done**.

plist feature configuration

This section is primarily for informational purposes as most users will configure the app via the MobileIron user interface rather than modifying the plist directly.

plist file structure

The app's plist file that contains the App-specific key-value pair configurations required for the app. The file appears as follows:

For each feature (see below), you can set the value to true or false.

Copy & paste

- **Key:** com.adobe.configuration.application.copypaste
- **Description:** Controls the availability of copy & paste. If enabled, document content can be copied to destinations out of the application.
- **Default:** true





Spotlight indexing

- **Key:** com.adobe.configuration.application.spotlight
- **Description:** Controls spotlight indexing. If enabled, search results containing document content can appear outside of the application.
- **Default:** true

Beta features

- **Key:** com.adobe.configuration.beta
- **Description:** Controls the availability of beta features. These features may or may not provide mechanisms that allow content to be copied elsewhere.
- **Default:** true

Share menu availability

- **Key:** com.adobe.configuration.application.sharing
- **Description:** Controls the availability of the Share menu. If enabled, the user can save, generate links, and open the PDF file within other applications via the Share menu.
- **Default:** true

File Systems access (connectors)

Access to Adobe's and other 3rd party storage providers can be enabled or disabled. By default, product features tightly integrated with Document Cloud and Dropbox.

Document Cloud and Creative Cloud

- **Key:** com.adobe.configuration.cloud.provider.extended.blue-heron
- **Description:** Controls the availability of the Document Cloud and Creative Cloud file systems.
- **Default:** true

Dropbox file system

- **Key:** com.adobe.configuration.cloud.provider.basic.dropbox
- **Description:** Controls the availability of the Dropbox file system.
- **Default:** true

Document Picker "More Locations"

- **Key:** com.adobe.configuration.cloud.provider.basic.coordinated
- **Description:** Controls the availability of "More Locations" in the source switcher. That feature allows users to open files from other applications/clouds using the iOS Document Picker.
- **Default:** true

Services

Mobile Link

Mobile Link is deprecated and this setting has no effect.





Enable Export PDF

- **Key:** com.adobe.configuration.cloud.service.exportPDF
- **Description:** Controls the availability of the Export PDF service. This feature requires the Document Cloud file system to be enabled.
- **Default:** true

Create PDF

- **Key:** com.adobe.configuration.cloud.service.createPDF
- **Description:** Controls the availability of the Create PDF service. This feature requires the Document Cloud file system to be enabled.
- **Default:** true

Scan to PDF

- **Key:** com.adobe.configuration.service.scanToPDF
- **Description:** Controls the availability of the Scan to PDF feature.
- **Default:** true

Enable Fill and Sign

- **Key:** com.adobe.configuration.cloud.service.fillAndSign
- **Description:** Controls the availability of the Fill and Sign feature.
- **Default:** true

Purchase Subscriptions

The feature controls whether end users can subscribe to additional services if the organization has not already done so; for example, Create PDF and Export PDF.

- **Key:** com.adobe.configuration.cloud.service.purchaseSubscriptions
- **Description:** Controls the availability of the Purchase Subscriptions feature.
- **Default:** true

Security Controls

You can configure security settings for the deployed app in the following locations:

- MobileIron Core Admin: App Catalog > Edit App > Managed App Settings:
- MobileIron Core Admin: Policies & Configs > Configurations > Add New > iOS and IOS X > Restrictions.
